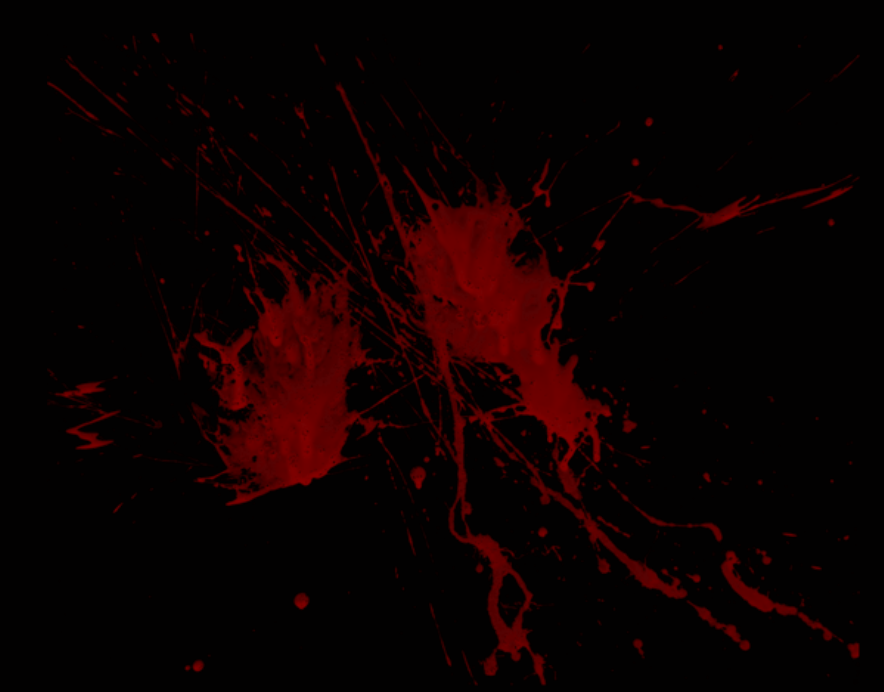

# PLOT SUMMARY

Former football star and Navy Seal, Myles "Miracle" McLean is on a mission to avenge the murder of his fiancée, Katie Sinclair. Blaming God for allowing her death, Myles cautiously teams up with ex-Marine sniper, Reverend Ben Stone as they embark on a journey of suspense, danger, and faith to hunt down those responsible.





## **Myles “Miracle” McLean (32)**

A former quarterback and Navy Seal, Myles earned the “Miracle” moniker for his heroics both on the football field and in battle. His current mission is to avenge and solve the gruesome murder of his fiancée, Katie Sinclair, while proving his innocence after being framed for her death by the corrupt local law enforcement.



## **Angela Sinclair (30)**

The attractive but resolute Police Detective who blames Myles for not being able to prevent her sister’s death. Due to Myles vast espionage experience, Angela’s hatred and animosity are on full display after he is called upon by her boss to aid in the seemingly unsolvable murder investigation.

## **Rose McLean (60)**

The widow of an ex-Naval officer, Rose's faith and inner strength are constant reminders to Myles, an agnostic that maybe there is a God.



## **Reverend Ben Stone (45)**

Former Marine Sniper and Rose's current pastor, Ben Stone, teams up with Myles to rescue his mother after she is taken captive by the murderer.



# SCRIPT SYNOPSIS

Former football star and current Navy Seal, MYLES "MIRACLE" MCLEAN is hell-bent on seeking revenge for the murder of his fiancée, Katie Sinclair. Although Myles was away on active duty and unable to protect Katie, her sister, DETECTIVE ANGIE SINCLAIR still blames Myles for her death. Her seething hatred towards Myles is evident as Angie is now under further pressure from her boss, LT. BRIAN CURRELLA to solve the case.

Myles', briefly meets local college coed, SAM at a coffee shop. Days later, she is also found murdered with a similar MO like Katie's murder. With an inconclusive coroner's report and very little evidence to go on, the police solicit Myles' to help Angie find the killer because of his espionage expertise.

Choosing to ignore Myles' suggestions and input, Angie is presented with questionable evidence, which unfairly implicates Myles in the death of the coed. Desperate, Myles reluctantly agrees to receive help from his mother's pastor and former Marine sniper/intelligence expert, REVEREND BEN STONE. Myles, resentful towards God for allowing Katie to die clashes with Reverend Stone and his faith as they attempt to devise a plan to solve the murder and clear Myles' name.



# SCRIPT SYNOPSIS (cont.)

As the police actively seek Myles' arrest, he goes undercover. The KILLER, who takes his orders from RAMIREZ, a mysterious CRIME BOSS, makes contact with Myles, wanting to setup a meeting. Hesitant, the killer is ordered to abduct ROSE MCLEAN, Myles' mother.

While trying to rescue his mother, Myles is caught and arrested, but with pressure from the Pentagon the local authorities grant his release.

As Myles and Reverend Stone zero in on the killer's location, a military intelligence report reveals that Ramirez's daughter was killed when Myles and his Seal Team were involved in a deadly raid against the cartel in Columbia. The killer is also revealed to be Ramirez former college roommate: Lt. Currella.

A dilapidated railway bridge is the climatic setting of Lt. Currella's final attempt to kill Myles. As an epic battle ensues, Reverend Stone, along with unexpected help from members of Myles' Seal Team, enable him to rescue his mother while capturing Lt. Currella.

Reverend Stone's faith and God's intervention convince Myles to become a believer. Angie and Myles also begin to forge a new friendship.

Ramirez, in the last scene screams, "This ain't over!"



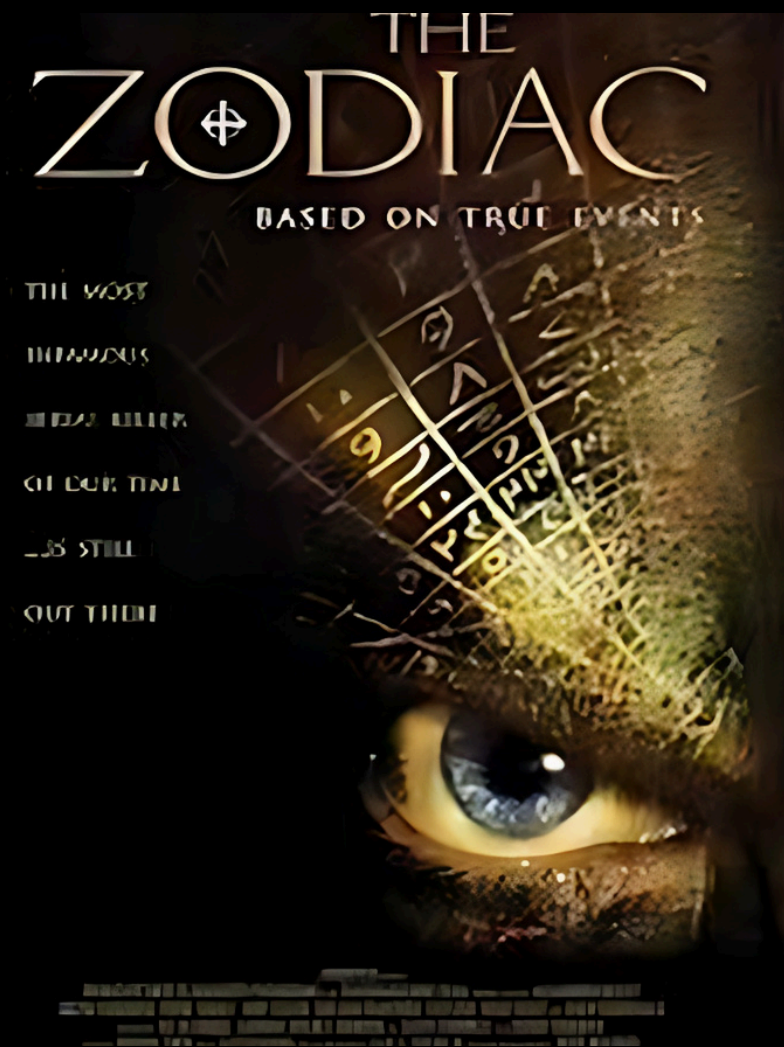

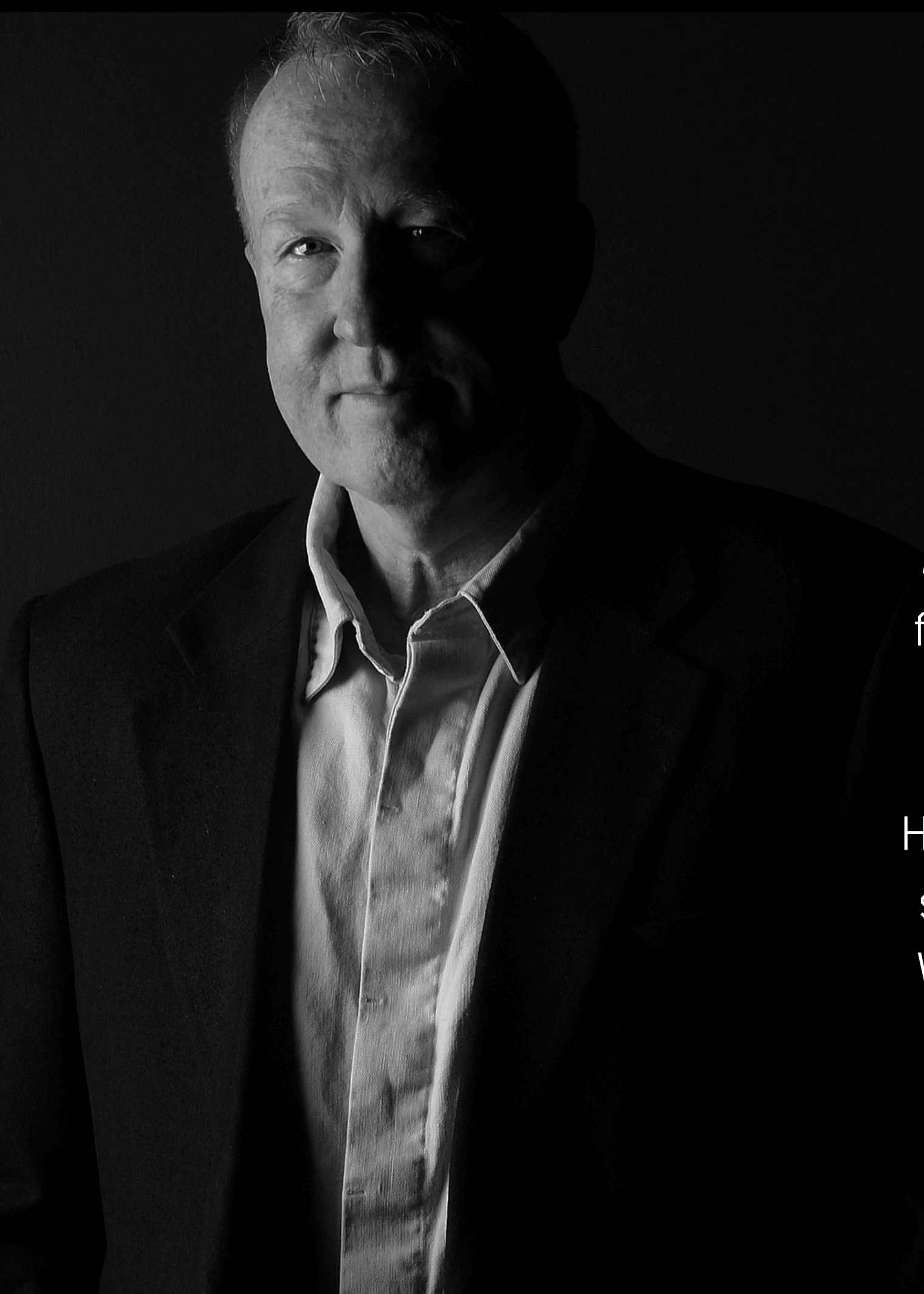
